Cllr C Sherwood updated that a letter had been sent to residents regarding planned works of A18 will commence in August 2026.

Update on Council Tax – General Council Tax increase by 2.7%. Less than the national average. Adult and Social Care Increase by 2%.

Confirmed to continue with Community Grant Pot, including In Bloom Grants.

Imagination Library, Free Car parking, upgrade at Sir John Mason House which will increase Intermediate Care Facilities.

200 more SEND places to enable children to remain in mainstream schools.

Leisure Centre passes free for two months for 66 years and over.

Data Centre at Elsham approved at Planning. Positives for the area. Completion of the centre will bring £1 million financial contributions toward parks and pen spaces for local area- including Wrawby.

Funding for cycle route from Barnetby to Brigg, Fully Funded shuttle bus between Brigg and site. £25 million for Data Education. Will heat 30 acres of green houses. 5000 construction jobs with 600 high value employed jobs when complete.

Heating oil grant to be managed by NLC.
